Signed the Florida ProLife Personhood Amendment Petition & Personhood FL's Personhood Affirmation indicating your intent to defend innocent human life from the beginning of biological development until natural death?
Use of tax revenues to support programs that provide condoms or contraception to minors without parental consent.
Institute neighborhood schools to reduce school bussing.
Increases in local sales or property tax to pay for education.
Stressing basic academic skills (i.e. reading/math) over social programs (i.e. healthy care issues, social engineering, values clarification issues, etc.)
Phase out advanced classes so children of all abilities take classes together.
Prohibit mind or conscience-altering practices such as yoga, guided imagery or hypnosis with students by school personnel without express parental premission.
Amend DOE Curriculum Framework for Biology and Life Science to also allow the teaching of interpretations of evolution and alternate theories of origins, including life by intelligent design.
Each year students should be given a standardized test to gauge the school's, teacher's and student's progress.
Include a majority of parents and non-school board employees on policy making committees.
Allow parents the right to withdraw their children from classes teaching material contrary to their moral values.
Tax funded education vouchers that allow parents to choose public aor private schools. (GI Bill for Kids)
Implementing curriculum that teaches grades K-6 students about preventing HIV/AIDS and other sexually transmitted diseases.
Sex education programs that include demonstration and/or distribution of condoms.
Do you support or oppose Common Core.
Abstinence sex education that gives information on refusal skills, STD's, contraceptives with their failure rates and no demonstration of condoms.
Permit teaching of the writings and documents of importance to the founding of the U.S. including references to religion in the lives of the Founding Fathers and the founding of this nation.
Permit student participation in National Day of Prayer and other prayer events.
Replace traditional A, B, C, D, F report card system with assessments and portfolios.
Replace teacher tenure with merit pay, which is awarded based upon student progress gauged by standardized test results.
