Signed the Florida ProLife Personhood Amendment Petition & Personhood FL's Personhood Affirmation indicating your intent to defend innocent human life from the beginning of biological development until natural death?

Pass an ordinance to prohibit abortion facilities from operating within 2,500 feet of a school, home, church or government building

Require voter approval for projects requiring long term debt financing

Exempt churches from impact fees and other use taxes.

Return local government budgets to 1999 levels, adjusted for population growth and rate of inflation and limit future increases in the budget to population growth and rate of inflation.

Increases in local sales or property tax to pay for education

Use federal stimulus money and/or federal grants to balance local government budgets

Health Insurance for "same sex" and live-in partners for employees of local government.

Mandating abortion coverage as part of employee health care packages.

Give "sexual preference, sexual orientation or lifestyle" minority protection status equivalent to that currently covered under existing civil rights laws.

Do you support or oppose Common Core.

Tax funded education vouchers that allow parents to choose public or private schools. (GI Bill for Kids)

Increase the number of charter schools.

Restrict use of office or commercial property to prevent use by churches on Sunday.

Permit crosses, nativity scenes, menorah and other religious items to be displayed on public property with secular

Ban possession of firearms within the city/county.

Permit teaching of the writings and documents of importance to the founding of the U.S. including references to religion in the lives of the Founding Fathers and the founding of this nation.

Fully enforce regulations applicable to adult entertainment facilities.
