Judicial candidates are severely restricted on what questions they can answer. We do not want judges pre-judge matters before cases are presented to them in court. For that reason I can not answer the above questions.

The main reason I am running is because my opponent is the only judge we have had on the Treasure Coast to have been reprimanded for his violations of ethical rules while on the bench. Judges are required to be neutral detached magistrates, the opposite of that is advocate which can be an admirable thing to be if you are not a judge. He wrote articles for the paper and actually sued the Sheriff, other judges, the public defender and the State Attorney. Yet, these agencies have to appear before him. The State Attorney for instance handles every criminal case in county court and they can not be expected to feel a person who has sued them is "neutral" towards them.

Top 2 things: Restore the faith of the county in a "neutral and detached magistrate", (Judge).  
Re-work the schedule so that cases can be handled efficiently.
